

Index description²

The Dow Jones Industrial Average SM Index (Bloomberg symbol: INDU) is a price-weighted index and includes 30 large-cap, "bluechip" U.S. stocks, excluding utility and transportation companies. Components are selected through a discretionary process with no predetermined criteria except that components should be established U.S. companies that are leaders in their industries, have an excellent reputation, demonstrate sustained growth, are of interest to a large number of investors and accurately represent the sectors covered by the average. The Index is not limited to traditionally defined industrial stocks; instead, the Index serves as a measure of the entire U.S. market, covering such diverse industries as financial services, technology, retail, entertainment and consumer goods. It is not possible to invest directly in an index.


